

## Master of Science in Leadership Development Program

### The Admission Process

1. For everything you need to know about admission to Wright State University's School of Graduate Studies:
  - a. Go to <http://www.wright.edu/sogs> for all links to assist with your application for admission and to apply online.
  - b. Admission requirements:
    1. Complete an application form
    2. Pay a nonrefundable application fee (\$25)
    3. Have an earned bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university
    4. Request transcripts from all schools you have attended
    5. Meet the minimum requirements for admission (see below)
2. If your cumulative undergraduate Grade Point Average (GPA) for all schools attended is 3.0 or higher, the MAT or GRE test requirement is waived.
  - a. If your cumulative undergraduate GPA is lower than 3.0, you must take the MAT or GRE and submit passing scores to the School of Graduate Studies.
  - b. Passing scores:
    - MAT – minimum of 380
    - GRE – minimum of 800 (combined verbal and quantitative)
3. Obtain two letters of reference. The letters of reference should be from individuals who are familiar with your work ethic, research abilities, and capacity for success as a graduate student. Have the letters sent to the School of Graduate Studies at:

4. Send a resume and sample of your writing\* to

\* The writing sample should be an expository essay of three or more pages.
5. Once all of the above have been received and all admission requirements have been met, you will be notified to schedule an interview with the MSLD Selection Committee.
