

Alumni Scholarship Awards

The College of Education and Human Services will award up to twelve \$500 scholarships and twelve \$1000 scholarships to selected students enrolled in full time graduate level programs in the college. These will be one time, non-renewable, awards for tuition and other fees posted by the university's Bursar, no cash refunds.

Criteria:

- Enrolled as a full time student in a CEHS graduate level degree program for the Winter 2008 academic quarter. To be considered for a \$1,000 award, students must be registered for 12 or more credit hours, to be considered for a \$500 award, students must be enrolled for 8 or more credit hours.
- Have not been awarded a Graduate Tuition Scholarship, Graduate Assistantship, Regent's Scholarship, Graduate Council Scholarship, Alumni Scholarship, or STRS Scholarship.
- Applicants are ranked by entering undergraduate GPA (if the student has not begun a program), or both undergraduate and graduate GPA if the student is currently enrolled in a CEHS graduate level degree program
- Test scores (GRE, MAT, Praxis, etc.) may be considered if needed to break "ties" or otherwise differentiate applicants

The Graduate Studies Committee established the criteria cited above and the process for selection. The number of awards available to each department's full time graduate students will be in proportion to the college's graduate student enrollment (based on enrollment figures published in the university's Fact Book).

Timelines and Procedures:

- Complete and return the application form to the CEHS Office of Student Services, 378 Allyn Hall **before** November 7, 2007. The form is available at:

- An award letter will be provided shortly after the application deadline. The scholarship award will be posted to your account and can be applied towards any academic expense you choose (tuition, fees, bookstore charges, etc.) between Winter 2008 and Summer 2008 (no cash refunds).
